Location

Description of practice location	We are located 10 minutes south of the city just near a large shopping centre and near bus routes on South Road at Edward St Melrose Park SA. It is in a commercial and residential area and attracts many different types of patients, from a wide socio-economic area.
Health and medical information about the region	There are a few medical centres nearby, with their own patient base and we draw patients from far south of the city and also north of the city. As we have a lot of doctors we usually have appointments available every day, and always see children with emergencies immediately. There are hospitals nearby if required.
Practice type and size	Large accredited practice open 7 days a week with 18 doctors and 5 practice nurses and varied allied health professionals who visit on a continuing basis. The clinic building has excellent facilities. There are 15 consulting rooms, 2 large waiting areas, 2 treatment rooms with an a hydraulic lift bed in each, nurse's station, offices and a lunch room. The treatment room has 5 nurses and caters for ECG, spirometry, cryotherapy, immunisations, removals and minor surgery. We focus on chronic disease management with our nursing staff, we have 3 psychologists and a Clinpath Pathology collection centre.

What access to specialists and other health professionals is available?	We have specialists who visit including psychologists, a visiting surgeon, gastro-enterologist, hearing group, a physiotherapist affiliated with us situated close by, podiatry, Clinpath Pathology as well as a pharmacy on

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site.

Aspects of medicine in your practice that will be a feature of registrar training	We see Workcover injuries, all levels of patients from babies to the elderly and through to shared ante-natal care, mental health patients and chronic disease management, which is a focus of the practice.

On-site and after-hours supervision to meet professional standards	Dr Rositano is always available either on site or by phone if he is not here, and the other doctors are more than happy to help as required.
Provision is made for registrars to attend education activities	Registrars are welcome to attend education activities as long as they allow us sufficient time to provide cover for their shift.
Access to clinical resources/reference materials	We have Medical Director as our clinical program, and many other online resources available including an ETG Complete, MIMS, accessing Fitness to Drive, RACGP Red Book, Bandolier etc, as well as many of the doctors having books in their consulting rooms to refer to.
Adequate consulting space, IT facilities and equipment for registrar	We have a consulting room per doctor and a computer in each room using a Terminal Server Environment, and looked after by an IT company. Each room and treatment room has all the equipment required at all times.
Appropriate space available for teaching purposes	The doctor will use his room for teaching, with appropriate time allocated
