Location

Description of practice location	Kapunda is situated approx 80km north east of Adelaide on the verge of the Barossa Valley. Originally a copper mining town, Kapunda has great historic significance to the region. With a population of 3000 people, Kapunda is in the heart of the Barossa Valley wine region.
Health and medical information about the region	Rural general practice, working in conjunction with the local hospitals. The Eudunda Hospital has 20 beds with three acute beds. The Kapunda Hospital has 23 beds and an operation theatre for visiting surgeons and local GPs who have regular operating lists.
Practice type and size	<p>Five doctors, two registrars, one mental health nurse, two medical students from Flinders or Adelaide Universities, five clinic nurses, one chronic disease coordinator and reception staff.</p> <p>The medical practice has five consulting rooms with an open plan treatment room consisting of three beds. Many services are offered including ECG, spirometry, immunisations, cryotherapy, removal of lesions and minor surgery.</p> <p>At present the practice is undergoing renovations to extend the current building to make room for an additional consulting room/office space. This will also include a conference room for the medical students with a dedicated study area.</p> <p>In the near future we will refit at the adjoining property to further extend our services to include visiting specialists and allied health providers. These will include: physiotherapy, IMVS, psychiatry, audiology.</p> <p>The doctors also offers after hours on call service through the local hospitals.</p>

What access to specialists and other health professionals is available?	The following services are offered by the practice: antenatal care, ECGs, spirometry, mental health care, minor surgery, suturing, cryotherapy, quit smoking programs, chronic disease management including nurse health assessments and care plans and women's health. Other specialists that visit Kapunda are: gastroenterologist, gynecologist, orthopedic, urologist, ENT, cardiologist, general surgeon. Also podiatrist, audiologist, physiotherapist, dietitian available locally. IMVS and Gribbles collect three times a day. Benson Radiology is available at Gawler, 25 minutes away. Limited services are also available at Angaston. Theatre is performed regularly at Kapunda Hospital with specialist doctors.
