A long history of registrar placements at the clinic ensures that there is a patient base ready to take over when a new registrar commences work at the clinic.

Facilities offered by practice

The accredited practice enjoys modern consultation rooms and is fully computerised.

The practice policy is to provide the clinical staff with quality clinical and diagnostic equipment which is reflected in the provision of the treatment room with ECG, spirometry, excision and procedures area, dressing and wound management area and a new dedicated children's immunisation room.

The waiting room is fitted with two plasma TVs with Foxtel programming, a beautifully painted children's play area and comfortable spacing for patients.

Our Kingston room provides a boardroom facility for meetings and a place to escape for lunches and coffee breaks.
