Description of practice location

Morphett Vale is located 26km from Adelaide CBD and is within the southern region of Adelaide. It is the largest suburb in the state with a population of 23,000 with over 1,000 businesses. Morphett Vale is the gateway to one of Australia's best wine regions, McLaren Vale and within 30 minutes travel time of the Fleurieu Peninsula.

The support staff include practice nurses, reception staff and an experienced Practice Manager to oversee the day to day operations.

The doctors at Medical One consult over a range of hours to suit their work/life balance. Holiday periods and frequency are also flexible to suit individual doctor's needs.

On-site and after-hours supervision to meet professional standards	Dr Janet Cantley is the designated principal supervisor and is accessible 80% of the time whilst the registrar is at the centre. Medical One is not open after hours (e.g. after 8 pm at night) and therefore no separate special provision is required. The registrar may consult one weekend shift every third or fourth weekend and would be rostered on with another doctor at the centre.
Provision is made for registrars to attend education activities	<p>Medical One has a structured system in place whereby formal teaching is preset within the first week of commencement by the registrar. A set day per week and time is agreed between the supervisor and registrar for GPT1s and GPT2s and then the appointment schedules using Zedmed are blocked off for the duration of the registrar's placement.</p> <p>Medical One has external educational speakers present to the doctors at the centre on a quarterly basis. This is based on the needs of the doctors.</p>
Access to clinical resources/reference materials	Medical One has an intranet with links to educational resources, templates for care plans, policies and procedures in relation to practice best management.
Adequate consulting space, IT facilities and equipment for registrar	The registrar has a dedicated consulting room that has a computer, peripherals, access to internet. Medical One clinical practice software system is Zedmed and training is provided as part of induction via webinar. We provide a mercury BP machine, stethoscope, auriscope, digital temperature, examination lights, examination bed, medical scales, syringes and needles – disposable, sharp disposal, height measure, tourniquet, thermometer, gloves - disposable and sterile (please refer to essential equipment checklist for additional information).
Appropriate space available for teaching purposes	Teaching would be held in the consultation room of the supervising doctor. We have a large onsite kitchen area where doctors meetings and
