Description of practice location	<p>Approx 1 hour south of Adelaide.          Located on main road in Yankalilla and attached to a modern aged care facility. Nearby popular holiday beaches at Normanville (2 minutes) and Carrickalinga (10 minutes).</p>
Health and medical information about the region	<p>The permanent residential community and district area population is 4327 (ABS census 2006) an annual growth of 2.4% over 5 years to 2006. Seventy (70) percent of these residents reside in the three townships of Yankalilla, Normanville and Carrickalinga.</p> <p>In addition to these permanent residents the area has an estimated 2700 additional non-resident (holiday home) persons which means a total 'township' population of 5700 (ABS 2006).</p> <p>The area population swells to over 10,000 during the summer holiday period with holiday visitors.</p> <p>The current "active" patient register is 4781 with 78% of these persons residing in the key postcodes for the district council area. The other patients reside in multiple other postcodes representing non-resident and holiday attendance at the practice.</p> <p>The patient register as recorded indicates a number of dominant chronic conditions including diabetes, asthma and CHD. As such the Practice has a major chronic disease program which reviews patient management and outcomes for each key condition on an annual basis.</p>
Practice type and size	<p>General Practice including an active Accident and Emergency Area and a Procedures Room used for minor procedures on a scheduled weekly basis.          Seven doctors (4.2 fte) work at the Practice. The Practice is seeking up to 2 additional full time Doctors.</p>
