

Educating Doctors for a Future in General Practice



Sturt Fleurieu is based in Strathalbyn and Adelaide and provides registrars with the opportunity to undertake both urban and rural general practice training. The region encompasses southern metropolitan Adelaide, the Riverland, Barossa Valley, Fleurieu, Adelaide Hills and the Murray Mallee.

The organisation works closely with its senior supervisors, teaching general practices, Divisions of general Practice, hospitals and the universities to ensure training is of the highest standards.

Sturt Fleurieu uses structured learning guides and self directed case discussion formats to guide registrar learning and ensure registrars successfully complete training.

To assist doctors make the transition from hospital to general practice medicine, and achieve a sound knowledge base, initial training is delivered using the '**gp-start**' learning program. '**gp-start**' is a fully self contained and accredited program which comprehensively covers the basics of general practice.

In advanced training registrars use '**gp-advanced**'. This encourages self direction using case discussions and small group learning, undertaken under the guidance of experienced Medical Educators and GP supervisors.

Other activities actively encouraged include procedural training in anaesthetics using the '**pro-start anaesthetics**' learning guide, obstetrics and surgery, and special skills training in emergency medicine is delivered using the '**pro-start emergency**' guide and computer simulation. Dermatology can be undertaken using the '**derm-start**' study guide or through specialist based clinical attachments and other specialist attachments are also available to enhance your learning opportunities.
